

COMPANY SECURITY POLICY

It is the policy of Astro Offshore Pte. Ltd. to provide a secure working environment, by establishing and maintaining the required security measures to prevent unlawful acts against vessels, which endanger the safety and security of personnel and property on board company vessel.

Company objectives are to:

- Provide security procedures and practices for vessel operations to protect the Security of vessel, ports and the wider community,
- Establish safeguards to reduce the risk to crew, passengers and port personnel on board company vessels.
- Improve the security skills and awareness of company personnel ashore and on-board vessel.
- Prepare contingency measures for emergencies relating to possible security incidents.

These objectives will be achieved by:

- A Ship Security Assessment and a Ship Security Plan specific to each individual vessel,
- Comprehensive training for company personnel, actively promoting security awareness amongst company personnel.
- Regular documented reviews and internal audits of security procedures and plans, in order to allow for constant update and improvement to the plan.

All employees are expected to comply with the required procedures within the ship security plan and should be familiar with the relevant security duties required of them and the measures required to protect the ship from any unlawful act

The company shall ensure that the Company Security Officer, the Master and the Ship Security Officer are given the necessary support to fulfil their duties and responsibilities in accordance with XI-2 of the 1974 SOLAS Convention.
