Astro Offshore pte. Ltd. believes that all incidents are preventable.

All personnel, employees and subcontractors, working at or visiting any Company vessel or premises shall follow these two key principles with regard to working safely at all times:

- Engage in all work safely or not at all.
- There is always time to conduct all tasks correctly and therefore SAFELY.

All personnel working at or visiting any Company vessel or premises have the right and obligation to STOP ANY WORK that they consider may create any unmanaged risk to personnel, the environment or assets. All personnel shall also support the STOP WORK decisions of others.

THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AND YOU HAVE FULL AUTHORITY

It is also an expectation and obligation for anyone stopping work in such circumstances to bring such conditions immediately to the attention of their immediate supervisor, who is responsible for informing the Vessel and / or Operational Management (as applicable.) Such Management must be involved in the assessment and resolving process.

No work will resume until all STOP WORK issues and concerns have been properly assessed and resolved-

The Company Management encourages and shall fully support STOP WORK decisions.

No form of retribution will be tolerated against any person who in good faith exercises his or her authority in conformance with the intent of this policy.
